

Title: Friendship Evangelism 2 (AA)

Age range: All ages.

Theme / Motivation

Seeing how many people are affected by the users of your prayer room, how many people your community is praying for and how far your prayer room is reaching out is truly inspiring. Hang a net across the ceiling and write the names of people you are praying for on a parcel tag. Lay under them and pray for people. Laying there is a bit like laying under a tree with all its leaves, to see each one of those leaves grow in to their own relationship with God is really exciting.

Design / Structure

Hang a net across the ceiling and write the names of people you are praying for at the moment and ask God to bring to your mind more people to pray for. Write them on parcel tag (left) and tie each one of these to the net, then lay under it looking up at all the people that are affected by those who are using the prayer room, pray for the people you have added and pray for names that others have added. You can even put a couple of prayer points on the back to help others pray for the names you write (don't write anything too personal!)



Make a sign explaining how to do the activity... 'Write the names of the people you are praying for and anyone else you want to become a Christian on a parcel tag (one name per tag) and hang them to the net. Lay under the canopy and pray for them and others'.

This is a particular idea is very helpful in defining the spatial elements of your prayer room as it can help break up large areas and lowering the ceiling can provide some helpful boundaries.

Materials

Pens
Parcel tags
String for the net & the parcel tags
Scissors
Net

Ways this could be adapted

As with all of the ideas in the Creative Bank you can develop and try any number of different methods, don't feel you must use the ones we have described. As an alternative you could use the net to create a 'Wailing wall' where people write out there heart cries to God.
